Shihan Wehrhahn has been training in Okinawan Karate and Kobudo since 1969 and began training in Kenjutsu and Iai since 1980. In 1984, he started his formal Iaido training in Japan under the late Master Mitsuzuka Takeshi Sensei, 8th Dan, student of the famous sword masters Nakayama Hakudo Sensei and Danzaki Tomoaki Sensei. Mitsuzuka Sensei founded San Shin Kai in the mid-1970's to help spread the art of Iaido outside of Japan. For almost 10 years, Shihan Wehrhahn has held the rank of 6th Dan in Muso Shinden Ryu awarded to him by Mitsuzuka Sensei. He continues to train with Mitsuzuka's son (7th Dan) and Mitsuzuka Sensei's 8th dan students in Japan. He was personally designated Shihan by Mitsuzuka Sensei, a special honor which means "master teacher". Shihan Wehrhahn is a constant student of the art himself and loves to share what he knows. He is currently producing a unique excellent professional instructional video series on Iaido to help students. He will be introducing the *Ugoki Tsuzukeru Katana* This standing kata is a great training kata as well as an exciting demonstration kata!
